Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.092, dated 07.10.2015, registered under Sections 22, 61 and 85 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel submits that seven out of eight prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the I.O. who is the last prosecution witness would be examined on the next date of hearing before the trial Court. It is therefore submitted that at the fag end of the trial, the petitioner be not admitted to regular bail.
