KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner alongwith Sahil Kumar and Varinder Singh are the injured witnesses in the case pertaining to FIR No. 185 dated 20.09.2017 under Sections 307, 148, 149 of IPC and under Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station, City South, Moga. Earlier, they had approached this Court by way of criminal petition bearing No. CRM-M-36423-2017. The said petition was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to approach the concerned authorities.

In compliance of the aforesaid order, the concerned authority was approached vide representation (*Annexure P-3*). However, no action in this regard is being taken.

In view the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to ensure that the petitioner who is an injured
