JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.80 dated 06.08.2016, registered under Sections 376, 420, 406, 498-A and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala.

On 07.11.2016, this Court had passed the following order:-

“On oral request, the petitioner is permitted to implead the complainant as respondent-party. Amended memo of parties be filed and thereafter notice of motion be issued, returnable for 07.02.2017.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer subject to the conditions laid down in section 438 sub section 2 clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the parties state that matter stand amicably settled during the mediation proceedings in terms of agreement dated 26.05.2017 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. It is

further contended that in pursuance of the order dated 07.11.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.11.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
