The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.222 dated 24.05.2017 registered under Sections 342, 354 and 506 of Indian Penal Code (in short IPC) and Section 10 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (in short POCSO Act) at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad during the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that wife of the petitioner has met with an accident and is hospitalized whereas, son of the petitioner is suffering from some viral. The learned counsel restricts his prayer to interim bail for four weeks to look after the ailing wife and the child.

In pursuance to the order dated 11.10.2017, the report of the Station House Officer, Police Station City Tohana dated 12.10.2017 has been filed in the Court. As per report, the son of the petitioner had been

hospitalized in Sangam Charitable Hospital, Tohana on 02.10.2017 and stands discharged on 06.10.2017 whereas wife of the petitioner was found to have met with an accident. She now stands discharged and is residing at her paternal home.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the son of the petitioner remained seriously sick and his wife had met with an accident, this Court feels that at such a critical juncture, the presence of the petitioner is required in the family to look after the ailing child and his wife.

In the circumstances, the petitioner be released on bail for a period of four weeks to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned and the date of surrender is to be indicated by the releasing Court.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
