ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 252 dated 14.09.2017, under Sections 294, 323, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 341 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the sections mentioned in the FIR are bailable except Section 506 IPC. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 03 months since his arrest and the complainant has not supported the prosecution case in his statement before the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Man Pal, states that the complainant indeed has not supported the prosecution case.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petitioner having been in custody for over 03 months and the complainant having not

supported the prosecution case, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Ramesh @ Dhamu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
