RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has prayed for the grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.106 dated 21.07.2016, registered under Sections 420 and 34 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, Punjab.

FIR was lodged by the complainant-Ravinder Singh Cheema in respect of cheating to the tune of Rs.19,50,000/- in which petitioner has played active role from the very inception. In a way the animals were fastened upon the complainant himself, particularly when he intended to sell his own animals to the accused party.

The complicity of the petitioner in the context of allegations, in my considered opinion requires custodial interrogation.

At this stage, this Court is constrained not to observe anything on merit, lest it may prejudice the case of either side, but in any case the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
