Petitioner-Dalbir Singh has filed this 4th petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.30 dated 05.04.2013, registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 324, 323 and 34 IPC and Section 302 IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

It has been brought into my notice that all the witnesses have already been examined by the trial Court.

Keeping in view the fact that trial is complete; nature and gravity of the offence and in view of serious allegations levelled against the present petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Dismissed.

It has been brought into my notice that cross-version is pending before the trial Court. Therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial of cross-version, preferably within 03 months from the next date, by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires.
