On 03.02.2017, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner by referring to identity card submits that the petitioner was wrongly declared as proclaimed person/offender vide order dated 19.07.2016 by presuming his name to be Sukhminder Singh whereas his real name is Sukhwinder Singh. Moreover, in relation to proceedings under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, the petitioner could not have been declared as proclaimed offender.

Notice of motion for 30.03.2017.

The petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court and join the investigation.

Let the petitioner appear before the trial Court on 16.02.2017 and in the event of his appearance, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court on each and every date.

Keeping in view the controversy involved in the present petition, let both the names appear on the order sheet in order to avoid any complication without meaning anything on merits of the case.”

As per office report, fresh notice issued to the respondent has been received back duly served. None has appeared on behalf of the respondent despite two pass overs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 03.02.2017, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail.

In view of above, order dated 03.02.2017 is made absolute. However, petitioner is directed to keep on appearing before the trial Court regularly.
