Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.18 dated 06.02.2017 under Sections 323/324/326/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the backside of the head of the complainant. The petitioner is in custody since 05.05.2017 and the challan has already been presented in the case. The other co-accused have already been admitted on bail by the Juvenile Justice Board.

Learned State counsel has argued that the petitioner has been attributed injury for the offence under Section 326 IPC, whereas the other co-accused have not been attributed any such injury. He

further states that the injured remained admitted in the hospital for 17 days.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner, who is 22 years of age, is in custody since 05.05.2017 and the trial in the case will take sufficient long time, coupled with the fact the other co-accused have been admitted on bail by the Juvenile Justice Board, he is admitted on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
