Rule.

Heard forthwith with consent of counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by the trial Court on
18.09.2015. However, now there is report from the chemical examiner
showing that the intoxicant powder recovered from the accused was
found to contain Diphenoxylate and its quantity is commercial.

In that view of the matter, the trial Court cancelled the
interim bail of the petitioner and issued non-bailable warrant against him.
In my opinion, the petitioner should be granted opportunity to apply for
regular bail before the trial Court since the FSL report has been received
recently and he was on interim bail for long period.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner for a period of 20 days from today, to enable him to apply for regular bail before the trial Court. In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer.

The petitioner shall apply for regular bail before the trial Court within aforesaid stipulated period i.e. 20 days. After completion of 20 days' period this order shall come to end without reference to this Court.
