The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.321 dated 13.06.2016, registered under Sections 302/34 IPC at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he in conspiracy with the co-accused Kunti wife of the deceased Joginder, have murdered Joginder. The evidence has been recorded before the trial Court. I have seen the evidence of PW-4 Karambir. Insofar as the present petitioner is concerned, looking to the evidence of PW-4, I think the petitioner should be granted concession of bail.

In that view of the matter, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspect of this case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. NO.M-38566 OF 2017 is allowed
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner has to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
