Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0669 dated 01.06.2017 under Sections 323, 325, 326, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Panipat.

Learned State Counsel has pointed out that in the supplementary statement, injured complainant has specifically made reference to the injury attributed to the petitioner that he has caused injury on his head and eye.

In view of the nature of injuries, no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
