In FIR No.285 dated 26.11.2015 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 324 and 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326-IPC was added lateron) at Police Station Khol, District Rewari, the petitioner is being prosecuted.

The parties to the dispute have now arrived at compromise (Annexure P-2). This Court had made an order dated November 07, 2016 directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report received from District and Sessions

Judge, Rewari, showing that indeed there is a compromise arrived at between the parties and statements in view of compromise have been recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.285 dated 26.11.2015 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 324 and 326 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326-IPC was added lateron) at Police Station Khol, District Rewari, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
