TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 19.07.2012, under Sections 409/420/120-B IPC and Sections 13(1)(d), 13(2) and 88 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Ferozepur.

While issuing notice of motion on 07.11.2016, the following order was passed by this Court:

“For having absented on 16.9.2016, the trial Court has cancelled the bail bonds of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner being unwell on that particular date was unable to appear in the Court.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 13.1.2017.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will put in appearance before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

During the course of hearing today, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner has since joined the trial proceedings and has been released on interim bail upon furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

In the light of the fact that the petitioner has joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the present petition is allowed. Order dated 07.11.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.
