SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 119 dated 7.7.2009, under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 and 506 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of SC ST Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Division Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 11.8.2017. More so, remaining accused in this case have already been acquitted on the basis of compromise having been effected with the complainant party and trial of the case still to take some time, so the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned State counsel while opposing the bail petition contended that the petitioner misused the concession of bail and remained away from the Court for a period of about 5 years and was declared proclaimed offender, so his bail petition be dismissed.

Having considered the above facts and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 11.8.2017 and other accused having been acquitted on the basis of compromise; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, therefore, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds with heavy surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

The present petition stands disposed of.
