The grouse of the petitioner is that despite information having been given to the police with respect to the cheating done by private respondents No.7 & 8 with him and District Attorney (Legal) Ludhiana having also recommended registration of case in the matter, FIR has not been registered since Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has observed that this dispute is of civil nature which is contrary to the factual position and further prayed that such Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana be asked to pass some speaking order.

In my view such type of direction being issued to Commissioner of Police Ludhiana is uncalled for. The petition is disposed

of relegating the petitioner to the remedy of filing complaint under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana or to avail of other remedy if so advised.
