The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner on the basis of an apprehension voiced against private respondents No.6 to 8.

Perusal of the pleadings on record and in particular a Legal Notice at Annexure P-8 would show that the petitioner has allegedly purchased land measuring 1800 sq. yds. on the strength of a full payment agreement to sell dated 02.08.2016 from the original owners. Grievance raised is that the private respondents are allegedly interfering in the peaceful possession of the petitioner.

Apparently, the dispute relates to a certain chunk of land and with regard to possession thereof.

The pleadings on record do not substantiate the apprehension voiced as regards threat to the life and liberty of the present petitioner.

In the considered view of this Court, no directions in regard

thereto are required to be passed.

Petition is dismissed.

Suffice it to observe that it would always be open for the petitioner to avail of the remedies as may be available in accordance with law.
