ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

 The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 361 dated 20.09.2017 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR are that husband of the complainant had committed suicide as he was not being paid the money which was due to him as commission for the recovery of loan. In the FIR, reference has been made to the suicide note wherein it is stated that co-accused namely Tanuj Madan was not giving him money and when he demanded the same, he was threatened by the petitioner and his co-accused. He further contends that it is mentioned in the FIR that petitioner was also there between them.

Learned counsel further contends that allegations in the FIR against the petitioner would not, prima facie, constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC.

This Court, by the order dated 14.11.2017, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 14.11.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
