The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.249 dated 19.09.2017 under Section 21 of NDPS Act (Section 27-A of NDPS Act added subsequently), registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR and he has been arraigned as an accused on the disclosure statement of accused Harjinder Singh, from whom 09 grams of heroin was recovered.

This Court, by the order dated 12.10.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar, states that in pursuance to the order dated 12.10.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 12.10.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
