ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.147 dated 19.09.2016 under Sections 452/336/427/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is the result of a sudden fight between the students during elections of Student Union. He further states that only simple injuries were caused in the incident and the matter has now been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 07.11.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jagraon, has sent his report dated 30.11.2016, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the students and only simple injuries were caused in the occurrence.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No 147 dated 19.09.2016 under Sections 452/336/427/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
