Kuldeep Singh, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner absented from the trial Court. He approached the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar for grant of anticipatory bail, who gave him seven days time to surrender. Another application was filed for extension of time. Vide order dated 31.8.2017, time was extended to 21 days from the date of previous order i.e. 17.8.2017 which means that the petitioner was given effective time of seven days more to surrender before the trial Court. The present petition was filed on 10.10.2017 i.e. after one month and 10 days of passing of the said order when the said seven days had elapsed. There is no ground to extend the time.

Dismissed.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court tomorrow, failing which, Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar shall apprehend the petitioner within seven days and produce him before trial
