Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.90 dated 17.11.2015, under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

It is informed that during the pendency of this petition, the parties have decided to part ways. A petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed. Their statements at first motion have been recorded on 13.10.2017. Part of the settled amount has been received by the complainant. A photocopy of the said statement of the complainant recorded before the learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar, produced in Court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that his client

has no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to strict adherence to the terms and conditions of the settlement by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jitender Singh, informs that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to order dated 07.02.2017. He is not reported to be involved in any other case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, specifically the settlement between the parties, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Consequently, order dated 07.02.2017, is made absolute.
