Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners (Jeth and Jethani of the complainant) have already joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 07.11.2016. They are ready to face the proceedings, in accordance with law, without any default. It is further submitted that as per allegations raised in the FIR, none of the articles of Istridhan has been entrusted to the petitioners, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

Counsel for the State has not disputed the factual assertions but states that articles of dowry are yet to be recovered.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of. Interim bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) they shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
