The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.592 dated 27.11.2015 under Sections 420/406 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-55, Faridabad, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise dated 03.10.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is the result of a monetary dispute over sale/purchase of the land and now the matter has been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 12.10.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, has sent his report dated 28.10.2017, wherein it is stated that in

pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties over the sale/purchase of land which has now been compromised.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No 592 dated 27.11.2015 under Sections 420/406 IPC registered at Police Station Sector-55, Faridabad, District Faridabad and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
