The petitioner who happens to be wife of the complainant seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.743 dated 16.10.2016, registered under Section 406/506 IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

During course of arguments, it transpired that before lodging the FIR in question, Arms licence of the complainant was renewed as per the norms. Concededly at the time of renewal of the Arms licence, the weapon has to be exhibited before the Authorities in order to ascertain whether the same is

in working condition or not?

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.11.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh admitted the aforesaid fact, however stated that the complainant has not cooperated in the investigation.

Without adverting anything on merits of the case, the interim order dated 07.11.2016 is made absolute.
