This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.191 dated 26.11.2016 registered under Sections 399/402 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act (Section 29 of Arms Act added later on), at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.
