Petitioner seeks a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action on her representation/ complaint dated 27.03.2017 (Annexure P-1).

The petitioner has raised allegations of harassment and ill-treatment meted out to her at the hands of her in-laws i.e. respondents no.3 to 7. The petitioner clearly has effective alternate remedies available to her for redressal of her grievance, therefore in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, 2008 (1) RCR (Criminal) 392**, no ground is made out at this stage, for interference by this Court in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.

Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to seek the remedy/remedies as may be available to her. It is clarified that there is no expression of any opinion on the merits of the case.
