Prayer in the instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 13.09.2017 registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148 and 149 (Section 325 added lateron) of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

According to the prosecution, at around 6:00 p.m., on 12.09.2017, some altercation took place between the complainant and the accused party in a function at the house of Harpal Singh. The relatives intervened and both the parties were separated. However, after half an hour, the petitioner alongwith his co-accused Jugnu and 4-5 unidentified persons, having swords, baseball bats and rods, came at the spot. The petitioner gave a sword blow on the left hand of the complainant.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that there is a cross case against both the sides. The aggressors were the opposite party. The petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Considering over all facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail, because recovery of sword has to be effected from him.

The petition is dismissed.
