This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.21 dated 08.04.2016, under Sections 307, 328, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Jarnail Singh @ Panna.

Allegations are against Aman Kaur i.e. wife of the complainant having administered mercury in rice, as also in tea of the complainant and having conspired with the present petitioner with whom she was in an alleged illicit relationship.

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Petitioner is in custody since 10.04.2016.

Learned State counsel submits that the report of FSL has not been received till date.

Keeping in view the allegations against the petitioner of being a conspirator and the incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, he is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

In the totality of circumstances and without making any observation on merits, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

Disposed of.
