Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of complaint No. RT-6 dated 04.01.2008, summoning order dated 13.10.2012 (Annexure P3) and the order dated 25.09.2014 (Annexure P4) vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 12.10.2017, the petitioner has surrendered before the learned trial Court and has been admitted on bail vide order dated 10.11.2017 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga. He has produced a copy of the order dated 10.11.2017 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, which is taken on record. He further states that the petitioner is regularly attending the Court and facing trial.

In view of the aforesaid fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the learned trial Court and is admitted to bail, the order dated 12.10.2017 is made absolute.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the learned trial Court regularly and will not delay the proceedings of the case.
