Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.58 dated 04.08.2017 registered under Sections 326, 324, 324 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise dated 28.09.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 12.10.2017 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements with a direction to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial

Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur and got recorded their statements. Report

from the concerned Magistrate has been received (in connected case CRM-M-38785-2017 'Lovepreet Masih and others vs. State of Punjab and others') vide letter bearing No.512 dated 01.11.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur vide Endst. No.8416/RKT dated 02.11.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur, the parties have effected compromise with each other voluntarily and without any pressure.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.58, is quashed qua the petitioners.
