By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.28, dated 06.03.2015, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 16.01.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.01.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
