The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of F.I.R. No.43 dated 2.8.2015 under sections 406, 420, 120-B I.P.C registered at Police Station, Sanaur District Patiala on the basis of a compromise which as per counsel has been entered into with the complainant namely Swaran Kaur.

Perusal of the impugned FIR would reveal that the allegations levelled by complainant Swaran Kaur are not only against the present petitioner but also against co-accused Kanhaya Lal, Suresh Kumar, Pankaj Bansal and Ram Kumar. They are all alleged to have acted in connivance with each other and having duped complainant of a heavy sum of money on the pretext of sending her three sons abroad.

The instant petition seeking quashing of the FIR is at the hands of one of the co-accused.

Being confronted with such a situation whereby this Court is not inclined to entertain the compromise quashing petition at the hands of one of the co-accused, counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
