The instant criminal revision has been filed seeking to challenge the impugned judgment dated 18.07.2009 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Faridabad, confirming and upholding the judgment of conviction dated 18.09.2008 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Palwal, by which the petitioner and other accused had been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of two years along with fine of Rs.2000/- each under Section 365 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code and in default of fine, each accused further undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months. The accused thereafter preferred an appeal against the said order, which was heard by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Faridabad. By the impugned judgment dated 18.07.2009, the appeal qua Path Ram, the petitioner herein was dismissed whereas, the other accused

namely Hukam, Mohan, Lallu and Ram Singh were acquitted. The petitioner, being aggrieved, has filed the instant criminal revision.

The matter was admitted and during the pendency of the criminal revision, the sentence of the petitioner was suspended and he was ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad by order dated 11.09.2009.

The matter has been taken up for hearing today. An affidavit has been filed by Sh. Yashpal Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police Sarai, Faridabad. A perusal of the affidavit reflects that the petitioner Pat Ram Saini s/o Khema Ram has since expired and his date of death stands registered at Serial No.446 dated 25.08.2014 in the record maintained by Registrar Birth and Death, Municipal Corporation, Sector 37, Faridabad.

In view of the fact that the petitioner herein has since expired, the proceedings in the instant criminal revision stands abated. No further proceedings are called for.

The petition stands disposed of.
