Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case presence of the petitioner is required in connection with any complaint made by private respondents No.4 to 8.

A bare perusal of the representation dated 13.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur reveals that there are allegations against the petitioner that he is providing Government job by creating some fake documents.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, this Court finds that no such direction, as sought by the petitioner, can be issued under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The present petition is, consequently, dismissed.
