The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.237 dated 24th May, 2017, registered under Sections 20-61-85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

The petitioner has remained in detention for five months now. The contraband allegedly recovered from him is below the commercial limit and there is no record of his involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act.

For these reasons, the present petitioner, namely Shamsheer Singh @ Shera @ Sherda, may be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
