The State has already filed its reply to the application. Action taken on the complainant has been mentioned. The same has been sent to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar as the complaint case falls under the jurisdiction of Commissionerate at Jalandhar. No further action is required on the judicial side in the High Court and the petitioner is relegated to his remedy under the Code of Civil Procedure before the appropriate forum by invoking Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. in terms of the Supreme Court decision in Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P., 2008 (1) RCR (Crl.) 392.
