ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.620 dated 03.07.2014 under Sections 148/149/323/427/325/452/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR, wherein it is alleged that accused named therein along with others had caused several injuries on the complainant. He further states that complainant has fully recovered from the injuries. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 01.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Rajesh Kumar, states that investigation has been completed and the trial is in progress.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is not named in the FIR and is in custody for over three months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Krishan @ Nambardar is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
