Petitioner-Jagdish Ram has filed this 2nd petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.171 dated 20.11.2016, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar, under Sections 307, 326 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution, the present petitioner was armed with *datar* and caused injuries on the left arm and head of Dilawar Singh.

Learned State counsel has submitted that main accused is Sanjiv Kumar alias Sanjay, who gave straight blow of the axe to Dilawar Singh with an intention to kill him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 23.11.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
