Vide award dated 5.8.2005 the Labour Court gave relief to the respondent-workman in the following terms:

“It is held that the termination of the services of the workman is illegal. The workman is entitled to reinstatement with continuity of service w.e.f. 22.6.1997. The workman is not entitled to back wages. The workman is ordered to produce himself for his services before the management within 30 days of the publication of this award.”

This led the workman to file the present writ petition challenging the aforesaid award. When the writ petition was admitted stay was specifically declined.

The representative of the petitioner and the workman have agreed that pursuant to the award the workman was reinstated in service and has since retired on 31.8.2016. In view of the above, the representative of the petitioner states that this writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
