Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.4 to 9.

Heard.

Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P/2), moved by the petitioner-Julekha as per law. He is also directed to verify the fact with regard to the age of petitioner No.1 and if she is found to be less than 18 years, then he is at liberty to take necessary action as per law. Further, if respondent No.2 is satisfied that the petitioners are actually facing threat, then he shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent, as per law.

With aforesaid directions, this petition stands disposed of.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
