Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have since joined the investigation and petitioner Satinderpal Singh has submitted his passport, whereas petitioner Kali Thapar has furnished an affidavit to the effect that he does not have any passport.

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that there was only a verbal duel between the parties and no such incident as given in the FIR had taken place and petitioner Satinderpal Singh has also submitted an application to the police that the version alleged in the present FIR is not correct and copy of CCTV footage has also been attached in support of those contentions.

In the light of above circumstances, interim bail granted to the

petitioner vide order dated 16.10.2017 is made absolute subject to conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
