The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.287 dated 08.10.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station City-1, Abohar.

The petitioner is present in Court today and he states that he will transfer 3 bed room set flat for the better future of his 12 years old child namely Tanmay but this offer has been refused by the complainant as she does not want to give divorce.

It is stated that recovery of 25 tolas of gold jewellery is yet to be effected. This question of recovery will be considered by the trial Court at the final stage of the trial.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.11.2015 is made absolute subject to the condition that petitioner will make an FDR amounting to Rs.5 Lacs in the name of minor child-Tanmay before the trial Court within a period of one month. The

petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The decision with regard to release of the above said amount will be seen by the trial Court at the final stage.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
