It is contended that the petitioner had married with respondent No.5 – Anupam Kumari against wishes of her family members in the year 2014. Both of them had filed a petition in this Court seeking protection, which was disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation of the petitioners and then to take necessary action warranted by the circumstances; that subsequently the spouses could not pull on together inasmuch as brother of Anupam Kumari attacked the petitioner causing injuries. The matter was reported to the police, however, subsequently it was compromised. Now respondent No.5 – Anupam Kumari along with her relations had been threatening the petitioner, hence the petitioner has approached this Court seeking protection.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3
- Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the grievance of
the petitioner as contained in Annexure P-4 and then to take necessary
action, if the circumstances so warrant, within a period of two months from
the date of receipt of this order.
