The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 19.09.2016 under Sections 452/323/324/506/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that they had tried to take forcible possession of the land, whereon houses of the complainant and others were constructed. He further contends that as per the demarcation report Annexure P-3, the house of complainant has been illegally constructed at Khasra No.368. He further contends that there is no allegation against the petitioners of having caused any injuries and even otherwise, the allegations against other accused are only of causing simple injuries. He also contends that a cross DDR has also been

registered at the behest of petitioner party as some of them, including petitioner No.4 Ajaib Singh, have also received injuries in the incident.

This Court, by the order dated 15.11.2017, had directed petitioner No.4-Ajaib Singh to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Darshan Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 15.11.2017, petitioner No.4-Ajaib Singh, has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 15.11.2017, granting ad-interim bail to petitioner No.4-Ajaib Singh, is hereby made absolute. However, petitioner No.4-Ajaib Singh shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
