Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already joined investigation in compliance with order dated 09.11.2016 and is ready to face the proceedings in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, concedes to this position and further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

(i) *He shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*

(ii) *He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and*

(iii) *He shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
