Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 324/323/148/149 of IPC (Section 307 of IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The only role attributed to the petitioner is that he was armed with daang and gave lalkara. He has given daang blow on the person of Luvdavinder Singh. He further states that pursuant to the order dated 13.10.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts and states that so far as the injury which attracted Section 307 IPC is concerned, the same has not been given by the petitioner but he has been attributed an injury on Luvdavinder Singh with a blunt weapon.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the injury under Section 307 IPC has not been attributed to the petitioner and considering the fact that this Court has already granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner vide order dated 13.10.2017, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.10.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
