The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.36 dated 28.07.2017, registered under Sections 316, 498-A, 406, 323 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Women Police Station, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Heard.

On 13.10.2017, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel contends that petitioner is the father-in-law and nothing is to be recovered from him

Notice of motion for 14.11.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*

2. *That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
3. *That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.*

To be heard along with CRM-M-38102-2017.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation but recovery of gold ring is to be effected from him.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is the father-in-law and he has joined the investigation in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
