The four petitioners in this petition seek the concession of anticipatory bail after having been named in the FIR registered for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under Section 306 IPC, i.e. that they had abetted the suicide of the father of the complainant, Vikrant Shoor, on 18.08.2016.

It is not denied by the learned counsel appearing for the State, or by the learned counsel for the complainant, that, as a matter of fact, the petitioners herein are not named either in the suicide note recovered, stated to have been written by the deceased, nor even is there any transcription of a telephonic conversation by the deceased with the four petitioners showing that they were also involved in the harassment of the aforesaid deceased, Vikrant Shoor, leading to his suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that even other persons who were named in the suicide note have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, other than one Ashwani Sehdev, i.e. the husband of petitioner no.4 herein.

The aforesaid contention is also not refuted by the learned counsel for the respondents.

In view of the above and the fact that the petitioners are stated to have joined investigation, the order dated 09.11.2016 granting them the concession of pre-arrest bail, is made absolute on the same terms. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when called upon and shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
