ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.91 dated 25.07.2017 under Sections 419/420/467/468/471 IPC registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR, which is lodged on the basis of secret information, are that petitioner was indulging in issuance of fake insurance policies of motorcycles, scooters and cars by disclosing himself to be agent of insurance company. He further states that only fake insurance policy booklet is allegedly recovered from the petitioner, but no person has come forward to report against the petitioner. There is also no instance which has been cited by the police where the petitioner has duped any individual.

Learned counsel further contends that petitioner is in custody for over three months ever since his arrest on 25.07.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that there is no instance of the petitioner having actually duped any individual and the petitioner is in custody for over three months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Jatinder Singh @ Sonu @ Jatinder Kumar is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, nothing observed herein above shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
